Ángel Rodríguez Lagunilla is an executive with almost 25 years of experience in automotive operations and manufacturing, acquired in the former Fiat Group, then CNH Industrial and finally Iveco Group.

He holds an Engineering degree from the University of Valladolid, Spain.

Ángel Rodríguez Lagunilla joined IVECO in 1998, rising through the ranks of the Company strengthening the industrial management system of the plants, designing, developing and implementing various improvement initiatives. In 2003 he moved to the Madrid heavy-duty truck plant as Head of Logistics and then as Director of the Cab Area. He was named Production Manager in Brescia, Italy, in 2008, at IVECO's medium-duty truck manufacturing centre; then in 2010 Plant Manager in Valladolid, Spain, at IVECO's light commercial vehicles and component plant. In 2012 he was named Head of the Madrid facility, during which time he oversaw the unification of the entire production of IVECO heavy-duty trucks in Europe. Thanks to his lean manufacturing and smart factory expertise, Madrid rapidly became the Group's benchmark facility.

In 2015, he was appointed CNH Industrial's Head of Commercial Vehicles and Bus Manufacturing for the EMEA region and, in 2019, was named Head of Commercial and Special Vehicles Manufacturing for IVECO globally. Since 2020 he has held the position of Chairman of Iveco España and, since November 2021, has led the Manufacturing organisation of Iveco Group.

Currently, Ángel Rodríguez Lagunilla is Chief Manufacturing Officer at Iveco Group.
